How will being a Camp Counselor Make a Difference in My Life?

- AND "Camp Counselor" looks great on college applications! A recommendation from your camp director makes a difference to that college recruiter!

How will I make a difference in the lives of campers?

- You will be guiding children building group skills and a sense of belonging.
- You will provide a safe environment, both physically and emotionally.
- You will be teaching skills that will give campers positive feelings about their abilities.
- You will be a role model--a mentor--a hero-- to the children in your care. They will look to you for guidance and you must set a positive example.

How do I apply?

Qualifications:

Age Requirements:

- Jr. Counselors: must be 15 by August 31 and/or entering 10th grade through age 17
- Associate Counselors/Sr. Counselors: 18 years old; high school graduate
- Specialists: must be qualified in specialty area with certification, i.e. Advanced Lifesaving, WSI, etc.

Personal Requirements:

- experience working with children and/or experience as a camper
- a strong sense of responsibility, lots of patience and ability to work with others
- be flexible, resourceful, imaginative, adaptable, plus have a sense of humor

Steps to take:

1. Call or email to set up an interview with the camp director.
2. Prepare for your interview.
